



In accordance with Articles 11 and 12 of the Law on Associations (Official Journal of the Republic of Serbia no. 51/09), the following Statute was adopted on the general meeting held on May 15, 2018 in Novi Sad:

STATUTE

Of the Association: „**National Green Roof and Terraces Association**“

Goals of Association

Article 1

The Association „**National Green Roof and Terraces Association**“ (hereinafter: Association) is a non-governmental and non for profit association established for unlimited period of time.

The Association is founded in the field of: ecological building, architecture, civil engineering, sustainable development and green architecture.

The association is founded in order to achieve the following goals and activities: setting the environmentally responsible building standards, introduction of innovations and environmental impact assessment. Underlining the examples of good practice and exchange of experience during its implementation.

In order to achieve its goals, the Association in particular:

- 1) Organizes and participates on expert meetings, seminars and conferences, both domestic and international
- 2) Makes and publishes studies, publications and other material in printed and electronic form related to environmentally responsible building
- 3) Cooperates with other associations and organizations
- 4) Conducts research and analyses results, collect the examples of good practice, analyses existing problems and proposes solutions in the field of environmentally responsible building
- 5) Performs other activities in accordance with the law in order to achieve the goals of the Association.

Name and seat

Article 2

The name of the Association is „**National Green Roof and Terraces Association**“.

The abbreviated name is „NAZ“.



The Association's name in English is „National Green Roof Association“.

The abbreviated Association's name in English is „GRA“.

The seat of association is in Novi Sad, 66b Bulevar oslobodjenja.

Membership

Article 3

Every person who reaches the age of 18 and accepts the goals of Association and the Statute, whose application for membership has been approved by the General Meeting, may be member of the Association.

The member may step out from the Association by giving the written statement to that effect to the General Meeting.

The membership in Association may cease due to the longer inactivity of a member, non-complying with the provisions of this Statute, damaging the reputation of the Association or based on the decision of the Association's General Meeting.

The decision on accepting the application for membership or cessation of membership is in the competence of the General Meeting.

Rights, duties and responsibilities of the member

Article 4

The member of Association has a right to:

1. Actively participate with other members in achieving the goals of Association
2. Directly participate in the decision making on the General Meeting
3. Elect and to be elected in the corporate bodies of the Association
4. Be promptly and fully informed about the work and activities of the Association.

The member shall:

1. Actively participate in achieving the goals of Association
2. Participate, in accordance with her/his interests, in the activities of the Association
3. Perform other activities entrusted to her/him by the General Meeting of the Association.



Internal organization

Article 5

The Association has following corporate bodies: the General Meeting and representative.

Article 6

The General Meeting of Association consists of all its members.

The General Meeting shall have a regular meeting once per year. The extraordinary meeting may be convoked at the proposal of the legal representative, stating the reasons for that, as well as at the initiative of at least one third of the members of the General Meeting. The initiative shall be filed to the legal representative in writing and it shall state the issues which will be discussed on the meeting.

The meeting will be convoked by the legal representative, based on the written notification on place and time of the meeting and proposal of the agenda. The president of the General Meeting will be presiding on the session.

The General Meeting shall:

1. Adopt work plan and program
2. Adopt Statute and changes and supplements to the Statute
3. Decide on membership in Association and exclusion from membership
4. Adopt other bylaws of the Association
5. Elect and discharge from a duty representatives of the Association
6. Elaborate and adopt the report of legal representatives
7. Elaborate and adopt financial plan and report
8. Decide on status changes and termination of work
9. Decide on association in organizations and other associations in the country and abroad.

The General Meeting shall dully decide if at least two third of members is present (quorum).

The General Meeting decides based on majority voting (50%+1).

Article 7

The legal representative:

1. Manages the Association and adopts decisions in order to achieve the goals of Association
2. Organizes regular performance of Association's activities
3. Entrusts certain activities to particular members
4. Adopts financial decisions
5. Decides on initiation of the procedure for changes and supplements to the Statute and prepares changes and supplements, to be submitted to the General Meeting for adoption



6. Signs contracts and financial statements
7. Decides on other issues which are not, based on the law or this Statute, in the competence of other bodies of Association.

The Association has two legal representatives.

The representative is elected for unlimited period of time.

Each representative represents the Association independently and without limitations.

Publicity of work

Article 8

The work of Association is public.

The annual reports on activities shall be submitted to the members on the general meeting of Association.

Article 9

In order to achieve its goals, the Association will establish contacts and cooperate with other associations and organizations in the country and abroad.

The Association may apply for membership in international associations, and the decision on this issue shall be in the competence of the General Meeting.

The manner of acquiring assets for achievement of goals and disposal of assets

Article 10

The Association collects funds from voluntary donations, donations and gifts, domestic and international projects, and financial subventions and in other legally permitted manner.

The Association may collect funds from fees for seminars and in any other manner in accordance with the law.



Cessation of work

Article 11

The Association shall cease with the work based on the decision of the General Meeting, when the conditions for achievement of Association's goals cease to exist and in other cases set by the law.

Dealing with property of Association in case of cessation of Association

Article 12

In case of cessation of work, the General Meeting will decide in the decision on cessation to whom the property shall be transferred, in accordance with the law.

Image and content of seal

Article 13

The Association has round seal with the following content: „National Green Roof and Terraces Association, citizens association, Novi Sad „written in Cyrillic letters.

Article 14

The Law on Associations shall directly apply to all the issues that are not regulated by this Statute.

Article 15

This Statute shall enter into force on the date of its adoption on the founding general meeting of Association and shall apply from the date of registration before the competent authority.
